A. Minutes: Kathleen Cullen moved to approve the Board of Trustee meeting minutes of September 8, 2009. Mike Murphy seconded the motion. Motion passed.

- **B.** Treasurer's Report: The current financial reports were reviewed. Eric Morti moved to approve the Treasurer's Report. Linda Kondris seconded motion. Motion passed.
- C. Marketing: Jack Hanna reported that he is working with Brett Kaysen and other breeders on developing a various financial livestock models and should have information for the Board to consider by year end. He is also working on marketing concepts to attract new breeders into the industry. The Board discussed the next PurelySuri magazine rates and how to attract advertisers. Rates and solicitation letter need to be settled by the next Board meeting.

Jack Hanna seconded the motion. Motion passed. Initial data will be coming from Susan Tellez's classification work and entered into the system developed by Dr. Enns. Cost for Susan Tellez's work has not been determined yet.

- **F. Education/Symposium:** Linda Kondris reported that she will try to have an outline for the 2010 Symposium by the next board meeting.
- **G. SNPDC:** Eric Morti reported that pattern sales have been going well. The committee is preparing for the fall fiber festivals in New York and Oregon as well as the fall seminars. The committee is looking into the possibility of developing program for fiber processing utilizing a mohair facility.

The Board approved by email on October 23, 2009, the committee's request to purchase approximately 400 lbs. of Suri fiber (after it has been approved via

sorting and grading) at an estimated cost of \$3,300 for use at spinning festivals, pattern development and research into weaving with Suri.
